iconic spaces

The Design Museum's seven different event spaces form one of London's most iconic contemporary venues.

Each space is housed under the incredible hyperbolic paraboloid roof, an original feature from this landmark building's former use as the Commonwealth Institute.

The atrium is the Design Museum's showcase space, providing a dramatic, triple height venue with stunning views of the iconic roof. Ideal for evening drinks receptions, awards ceremonies and dinners.

The Grade II* listed structure is the only public building designed by John Pawson and provides an engaging and exciting setting for visitors, or for spectacular corporate events.
