Our commitment starts with our values and is supported by our culture which is shared by our students, our team and our partners.

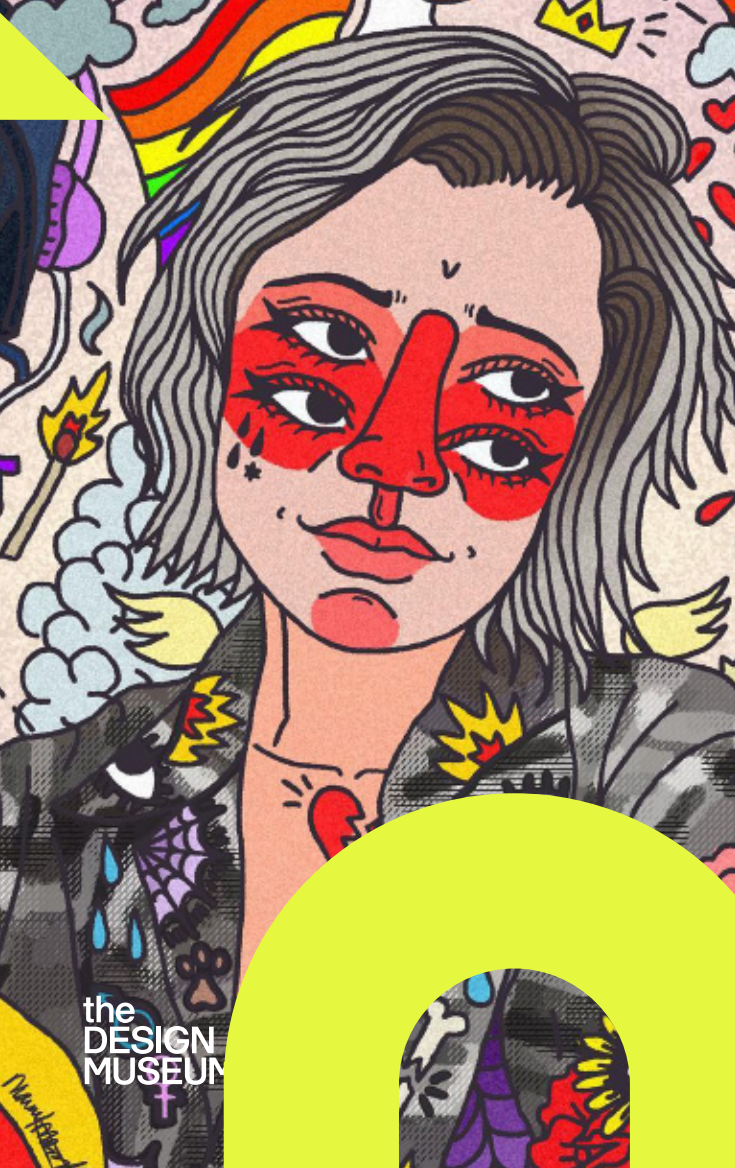
We believe that we will all benefit from a journey of personal growth, if we commit to a shared culture which is:

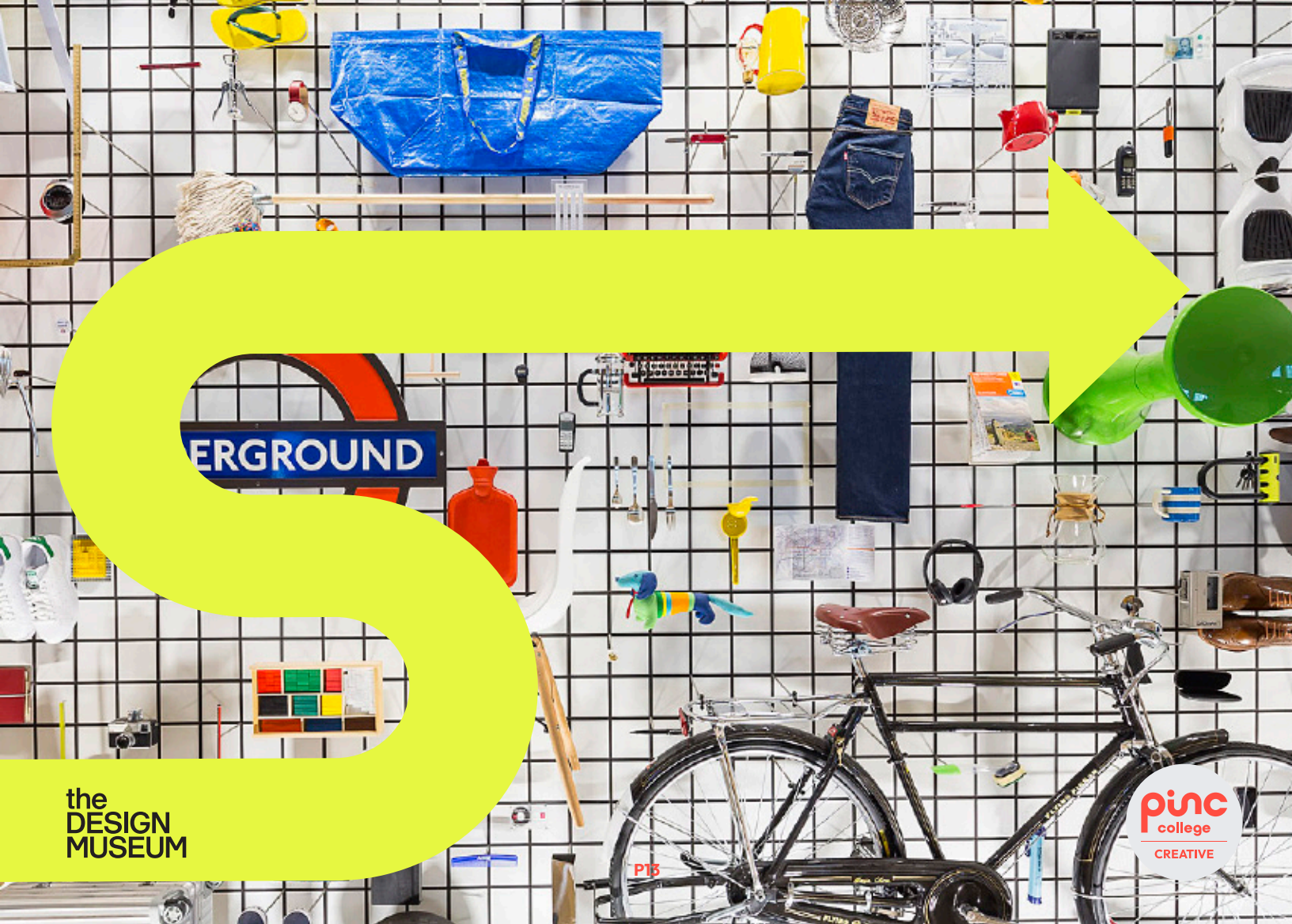

Through our Creative Futures Modules we offer a range of opportunities. This enables our students to take informed decisions about their future throughout their time at Pinc:

- Individual support to clarify future options

- Work placements, experiences, journey planning and travel confidence
- Progress onto a Supported Internship, working with local employers in the creative and cultural sectors

1 year supported internship

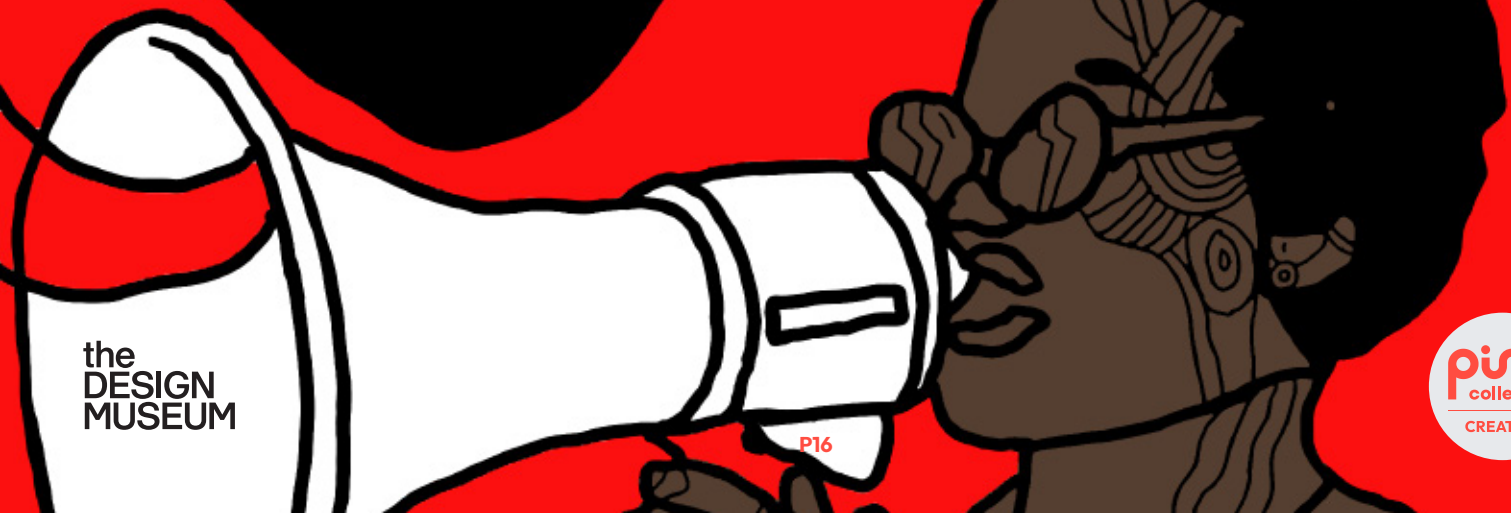
Our **Pathways Programme** is a one year programme which supports our Students on their journey into Cultural and Creative Sector careers.
